Dear Parents/Guardians,

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself as your child's Year 3/4 class teacher. My name is Brett Osborne and I grew up in Whyalla, and then moved with my family to Adelaide. I have been living in Port Lincoln for the past eight years. This is the beginning of my ninth full year of teaching, having previously taught at Long Street Primary School, Lincoln Gardens Primary School and also the last seven years at KPPS. I am a keen sportsman and also enjoy water sports including fishing, surfing and diving. I have a beautiful wife and 2 incredibly beautiful daughters aged 3 ½ years and 14 months.

There will be a **Parent Information Session** in Week 3, Wednesday 14th February from 6:15pm to 7:00pm in Room 3. This time will be just for parents of students in this 3/4 class, and will run for approximately 40 minutes. The session will provide you with information regarding upcoming events, requirements for the year and allow time for any questions you have. Other than this, you can arrange to meet with me before or after school or, alternatively, call the school, where I can return the call to discuss anything you may wish to bring up. Parent/Teacher/Child conferences will be held in Weeks 8-11, with letters coming out later in the term to organise a time for you to meet and discuss your child's learning journey.

School and lesson times are unchanged this year, with students expected to be in classes by 8:45am. Classroom doors will be opened by 8:30am. A communication book will be sent out in the first week for any communications between school and home. Absentee notes and any other information you may wish to provide can be put in this communication book.

We have swimming lessons at some time in week 4, 5 or 6 (yet to be confirmed). Crunch and Sip time will be provided, with your child encouraged to bring in a water bottle and fruit or vegetables to be consumed in class. Broad brimmed hats are also required for all students participating in outdoor activities in Terms 1 and 4 and I encourage students to be wearing their hats in term 2 and 3 on days with a high UV rating.
