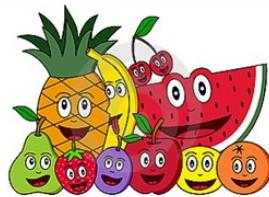
Parents are invited to the Parent Information Session in Week 3, in Room 25
