




## LITERACY WRITING

## Term 3 Learning Highlights!

### MATHEMATICS

Students have also been busy learning different number strategies for addition. We have learnt chunking, number splitting, jumping and column addition. Students didn't take long to work out what strategy they preferred to use. They have also been exploring chance and data through various hands on activities. Through these hands-on experiments, students investigated dice patterns, coloured spinners and coin tossing. Students have explored different types of graphs and learnt to collect and analyse data that is represented. We conducted various whole class surveys on different topics such as favourite ice cream flavours, drinks and sport.

In the coming weeks students will investigate subtraction strategies and 2D/3D shapes.
